


- □ 6.4 million Californians at or below the IOLTA financial requirements

- □ One in five children





The Need: Special Populations


- ☐ CA Seniors: < 200% of poverty

 - 57.5% of senior couples





- ☐ Projected population growth of 154% between 2000 and 2040.

The Need: Language Access

- More than 4 million households are "linguistically isolated"
- ☐ 40% speak language other than English at home








The Need: Rural Californians


- □ Rural CA = 76% of the state

- □ 1.6 million eligible for legal services


